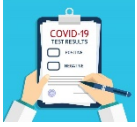

	<p>NEW since September 1st! We have added AFTERNOON SNACK to our school's menu, provided to all students from Kindergarten to 4th grade.</p> <p>The updated September Breakfast-Lunch-Snack Menu is posted on our website.</p> <p>Scholars bringing breakfast/lunch from home must bring it with them at arrival, the main office <u>does not</u> accept/deliver breakfast and lunch from parents dropping off after arrival to classrooms.</p>
<p>P-EBT FOOD BENEFITS UPDATE</p> <p>Many families have reached out regarding the Pandemic-EBT Food Benefits for our school.</p>	<p>New York State continues to distribute Pandemic-EBT food benefits to all households with eligible children who should have received free school lunch under the National School Lunch Act during school year 2020-21.</p> <p>We have been informed to alert families that P-EBT payments for our school should not be expected before October. The state is still working on Charter School payments. For updated information, please click HERE.</p>
<p>LATENESS & LATE PICK-UP</p> 	<p>Scholars are marked <i>LATE</i> if they arrive after 8:00am and picked up after 3:15pm (Monday - Thursday) or 1:15pm (Fridays). Late Arrival is part of your child's record. Arriving late also means your child misses an important part of the day, community morning meeting!</p> <p>Late dismissal means that our staff are unable to participate in afternoon PD and meetings. Please be sure you arrive for pick-up PRIOR to 3:15 or 1:15.</p>

Ensure you are not sending your child to school if they do not feel well, especially if they have a COUGH, a symptom of Covid-19. Your child will be sent home if the nurse does not have a pre-diagnosis of Asthma or Allergies and your child is coughing. Note, when you answer the [Daily Passport Questions](#) for building entry, question #2 asks about coughs. Please ensure you are reviewing and answering the questions correctly prior to coming to school. If the answer is **yes**, please keep your child at home until symptoms improve and they take a Covid-19 test.


